BUILT FROM MOVEMENT.

Jon Thomas Buck is an entrepreneur, walker, and builder from Joplin, Missouri. After surviving the 2011 Joplin tornado and rebuilding his own life through movement, service, and community, he walked 3,146 miles in one year.

Those miles became the foundation for work built around a simple belief: movement changes people, and people who move together can change a community. Jon is building The MOVE. Community and a connected ecosystem focused on contribution, local ownership, shared prosperity, and local reinvestment.

He calls this community-first model Joint Capitalism: contribution, ownership, and reinvestment working together so more people can help create value, build a stake, and strengthen the place around them.
